PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project expands K-68 to four lanes between US-169 and Spring Valley Road, a distance of 6.68 miles. This project is part of the Eisenhower Legacy Transportation Program (IKE) Projects for KDOT District 4 (Southeast Kansas). Construction is expected to start in early 2025.

The Miami County K-68 Expansion is also related to the K-68 T-WORKS projects, including widening K-68 to a four-lane expressway from U.S. 69 to Spring Valley Road.
