ABOUT THE PROJECT

KDOT's West Lawrence U.S. 40 (6th Street) and K-10 Interchange Improvements Project will reconfigure the existing interchange into a diverging diamond interchange (DDI). A DDI enhances safety and mobility by reducing potential crash points at intersections and by allowing more vehicles to move through the intersection. The interchange will include a sidewalk with barriers down the center of the bridge to provide protection for pedestrians.

PROJECT CONSTRUCTION IS UNDERWAY

The West Lawrence U.S. 40 (6th Street) and K-10 Interchange Improvements Project includes multiple enhancements to transform the interchange into the western gateway of Lawrence that will benefit drivers, pedestrians and cyclists. The work, which is already underway, is expected to be completed by the end of 2024. This is the first diverging diamond interchange (DDI) to be constructed in Lawrence. The closest open DDI is in Olathe at K-10 and Ridgeview Road.

KDOT is working to deliver this project in phases to reduce the amount of time the interchange will be closed to traffic. The following graphic highlights the three planned phases.

PHASES 1 AND 2

U.S. 40 between E. 800 and E. 900 Roads is closed for the duration of the project.

DIVERGING DIAMOND INTERCHANGE (DDI) BENEFITS

The DDI is a design innovation that improves safety and mobility, often at a much lower cost, compared to conventional interchange designs. The benefits include:

- Safe and convenient bridge crossings for pedestrians and cyclists.
- Traffic signals that can be activated by pedestrians and cyclists.
- Sidewalk with barriers to cross the bridge.

- Local access remains open.
- E. 900 Road connection north of U.S. 40 reconstructed and shifted west.
- E. 900 Road south of U.S. 40 closed. Cul-de-sac constructed for local traffic.

PHASE 3 Interchange Improvements Summer 2024

- Full interchange closure.
- Expected completion end of 2024.
- K-10 and U.S. 40 ramps redesigned and rebuilt to create diverging diamond interchange.
