PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) is completing a discovery phase study exploring options to reconstruct and expand U.S. 54 from U.S. 83 (the former Six Points intersection) northeast to Tucker Road. Once complete, the project will tie into the U.S. 54 expansion project currently under construction from Tucker Road to County Road O.

The design team is moving forward with the top two community-preferred options to reconfigure the former Six Points intersection (identified in July of 2023). Additional details including potential impacts and changes to highway access are now available for public input. Multiple factors, including public input, will go into the selection of a preferred option.

The U.S. 54 corridor currently carries approximately 7,000 vehicles daily, including 2,000 trucks. The goal of the discovery phase study is to enhance safety, reduce congestion and support economic growth in the region.
