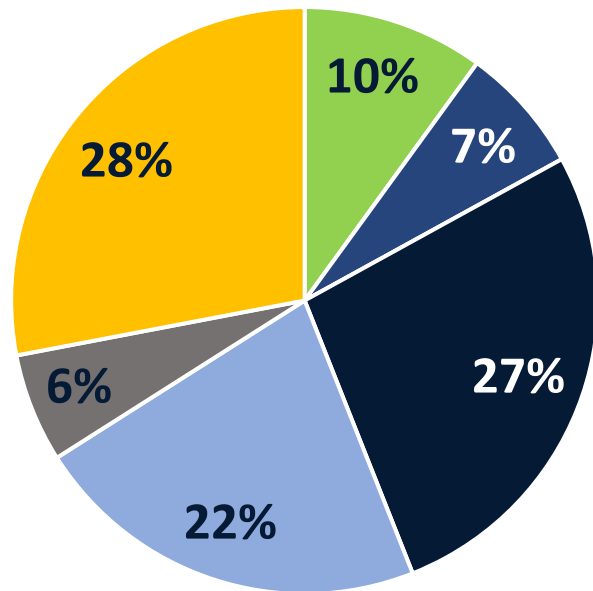

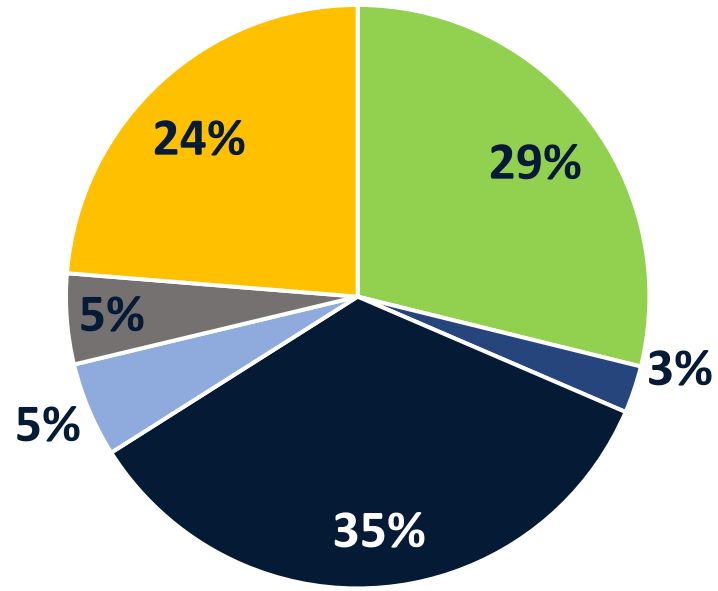
Greenhouse Gas Emissions by Economic Sector

United States

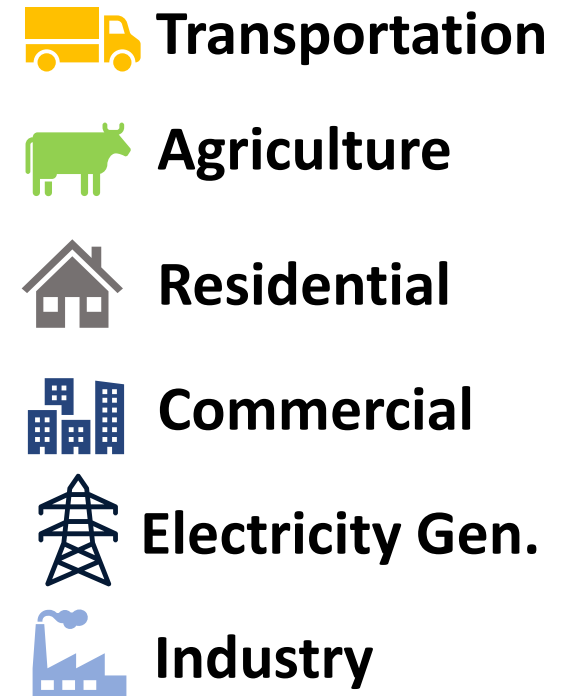

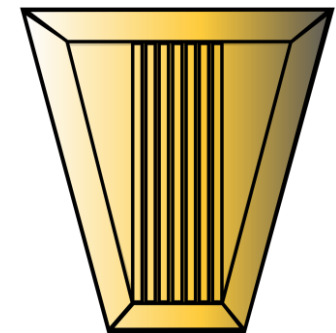
